



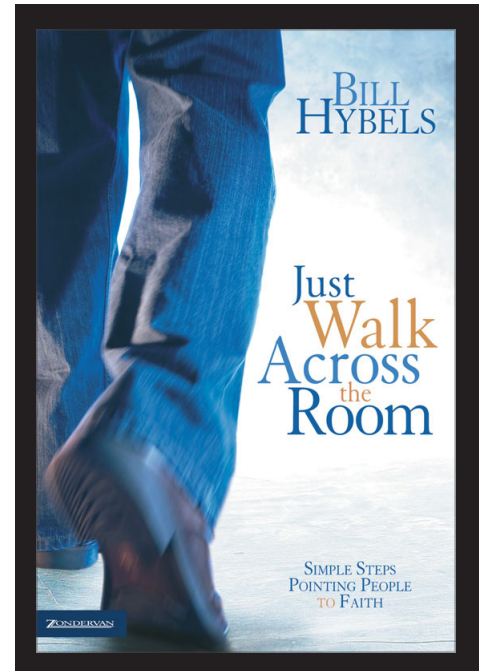
Welcome
